### Resolution to Protect DACA

On Thursday Aug. 17th, Wallingford Indivisible, North Seattle Indivisible, Indivisible Bainbridge Island, and Indivisible Kirkland/Kenmore met together with Rep. Jayapal's office, Sen. Cantwell's office, and Sen. Murray's office and presented a resolution asking that they support DREAMers and DACA recipients signed by 47 organizations across the state of Washington. ### S 1615 & HR 3591

The U.S. House and Senate have reintroduced the DREAM Act, legislation that has previously enjoyed overwhelming bipartisan support. Ask our senators to co-sponsor S 1615, a bipartisan Senate bill to make DACA rights secure, and call your Representatives to ask that they cosponsor HR 3591, the bipartisan House companion bill.

"DACA grants a work permit and protection from deportation to about 750,000 undocumented immigrants brought to the country as children."
