DACA

S 1615 & HR 3591

The U.S. House and Senate have reintroduced the DREAM Act, legislation that has previously enjoyed overwhelming bipartisan support. Ask our senators to co-sponsor S 1615, a bipartisan Senate bill to make DACA rights secure, and call your Representatives to ask that they cosponsor HR 3591, the bipartisan House companion bill.

DACA program is "relief from deportation to individuals who came to the U.S. as children, if they met a number of requirements (like background checks)." According to: www.indivisibleguide.com/.
